Design Solution

The Lake Eva Park Pavilions are made up of integrated signage, hip roof shelters and gable roof shelters with corbels attached to the roof and columns. The largest shelter includes a clerestory feature, and can accomodate many picnic tables. Most of the pavilions are located adjacent to a water feature, such as a pool or a lake, and provide a cool gathering place on those scorching hot summer Florida days. Each of the pavilions coordinates with one another, creating both a functional and pleasing aesthetic. Poligon was able to custom design, engineer, and manufacture the entire project both under budget and on schedule.
